

St Andrew's Cathedral School (SACS) is an Anglican school, with a vision to inspire students to become passionate, creative learners who engage with the message of Christ and fully develop their gifts and abilities in order to serve in the world.

We seek to fulfil the commission of Romans 12:2 in the Bible – assisting our students to think through the prism of a Christian worldview, and to critique the dominant secular philosophies of society through this lens.

Our Christian education programmes seek to be authentic and engaging for young people – from Christian Development classes and Chapel services to voluntary lunchtime Crusaders groups and camps.

With over 40 music ensembles, including our famous Cathedral Choristers, as well as a large choice of sports and more than 20 co-curricular groups (think debating, drama and outdoor education), we offer an incredible spectrum of opportunities to cater to diverse student talents and interests.

SACS is adjacent to Town Hall Station and major city bus routes, making it easy for students to reach us from all over Sydney.

Our drop-zone for cars enables parents who work in the city to safely deliver their children to school.

We offer before school care (6.30am - 8.15am), after-school care (3.00pm to 6.00pm) and SACS Holiday Care during school holiday periods to Junior School students.

Junior School (Kindergarten - Year 6)

Our Junior School is a happy and vibrant school with an ethos centred on developing the Heart, Mind and Life of each student.

How our Junior School inspires true excellence:

- Small class sizes, with year group and stage-based accelerated classes for highly gifted students
- Specialist teachers across music, drama, science, service learning, Christian studies and the Mandarin language
- Many teaching staff are trained in the Primary Years Programme of the International Baccalaureate, a globally recognised education initiative
- Access to St Andrew's trained Enrichment and Learning and Gifted and Talented teachers
- Before and after school and vacation care for busy parents.
- Our open-plan learning area is also shared by Gawura, a separate K-6 school within a school for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.




