#### Application Fee

\$450 per student (non-refundable).

#### Enrolment Fee

\$2,500 per family (non-refundable).

#### Enrolment Bond

\$10,000 per student on acceptance – credited to the final account in the year the student leaves and paid within four weeks of a claim being received.

\$1,080 per student (subject to Board of Studies advice).

##### Tuition fees

Tuition fees are payable at the commencement of each School Term\*, as per the terms and conditions of enrolment. Fee statements for Term 1 will be mailed in mid January and one or two weeks before the commencement of Terms 2, 3 and 4.

**The due dates are 8 February, 11 May, 3 August and 25 October.** If Tuition Fees are not received by the due date a late fee of \$150 will be charged.

##### Building Fund Donations (Tax deductible)

A donation to the Building Fund when paying tuition fees enables the ongoing

development of dynamic and engaging learning spaces. From new classroom designs that promote innovative teaching and learning, to complete refurbishment of science laboratories in BBC, all donations to the Building Fund benefit St Andrew's students directly. All schools need to raise funds for capital and building development, and St Andrew's is grateful for the ongoing generosity of our community. A target has been set of \$175 per family for each of the four terms (year 12 is \$233 for each of the three terms) and all contributions are tax deductible.

##### Outdoor Education Program

The School's curriculum includes an Outdoor Education Program for all students in Years 3 to 10. Students will be excused from this programme only on medical grounds at the discretion of the Head of School.

<sup>^</sup> Years 9 and 10 have additional options, which will be advised by the Head of Outdoor Education, and the cost of these will be in addition to the minimum fee if selected.

##### Extended Study Centre (ESC)

Students have the opportunity to take part in the After-Hours Middle School and Senior College Extended Study Program. The cost is in addition to tuition fees. Information about the program and cost will be sent in early Term 1. Once students start the program they

are committed to completing the term.

##### International Baccalaureate

Students participating in the International Baccalaureate course will be charged an additional \$150 per Term for Year 11 and \$200 per Term for Year 12 (3 payments) for external costs charged to the School for the course.

##### Notice of Withdrawal From School

It is necessary to give the Head of School a full term's notice in writing. In default of such notice, one term's fees in settlement of liquidated damages will be payable.

**\*Year 12 are billed for 3 terms instead of 4 terms.**

## Additional costs for compulsory items

### Curriculum & Activity Charges

The majority of costs are covered by a predetermined fee (see details on Student Charges Information Sheet).

### School uniform

Purchased through the School's Uniform Store, the uniform includes the school uniform worn by the students daily, sports uniform, school bag and sports bag. There is also a separate uniform for students involved in music performances. Approximate costs are: Kindergarten to Year 6 - \$1100; Years 7 to 9 - \$1250; and Years 10 to 12 - \$1200.

## Optional activities

### After school care programme and study centre

The Junior School After School Care Programme (for students in Kindergarten to Year 6) is open from 3.15 pm until 6.00 pm Monday to Friday at a cost of \$25.52 per session for a permanent booking or \$29.56 per session for a casual booking. Middle School Study Centre (for students in Year 7 to 9) is open Tuesday to Friday from 3.15 pm until 7.00 pm. Students can book in for 1 or 2 nights per week at a cost of \$470 per term for one night per week and \$940 per term for two nights per week. Senior Study Centre (for students in Year 10 to 12) is open Monday 4.30 pm to 7.30 pm and Tuesday to Thursday from 4.00 pm to 7.00 pm at a cost of \$350 for one night per term.

### Building fund contribution (tax deductible)

Parents will recognise the need to raise funds for capital and building development within the School. Such funds allow the School to plan with confidence and maintain educational facilities for all students. \$160 per family per Term (or \$210 per Term for family of Year 12 students only) is recommended as the suggested contribution to the building fund.

### Private music tuition

Students may undertake private music lessons once a week during term time. Instrumental lessons are \$40 for 30 minutes, Group lessons are \$17.50 for 30 minutes and Music Craft lessons are \$14 for 30 minutes. Students are able to hire instruments from the School at an extra cost.

### Overseas trips

Interstate and overseas trips are organised from time to time. These are optional activities and include music tours, sports tours and cultural tours. Costs vary according to the duration of the trip and countries visited. Average cost is between \$2,000 and \$8,500.

### Sport and extra-curricular activities

Extra non-compulsory activities are available to students e.g. Duke of Edinburgh programme, dance classes, gala day activities, purchase of School photos, etc. and incur an extra cost.

### Travel to and from school

Overseas students are issued with a Student ID Card enabling them to obtain student concession rates when travelling to and from school on trains and buses.
