Melinda Tankard Reist is an author. speaker, media commentator, blogger and advocate for young people. She is best known for her work addressing sexualisation, objectification, harms of pornography, sexual exploitation, trafficking and violence against women. An Ambassador for World Vision Australia, Compassion Australia, HagarNZ and the youth mentoring body the Raise Foundation, Melinda is also Senior Lecturer in the Centre for Culture and Ethics, Notre Dame University, Sydney. Melinda is named in the Who's Who of Australian Women and the World Who's Who of Women.

Children are bombarded with hypersexualised messages from media and popular culture from a young age and the impact of pornography on adolescents is an ever-growing concern. But what can parents and carers do to navigate this difficult issue with their children?
